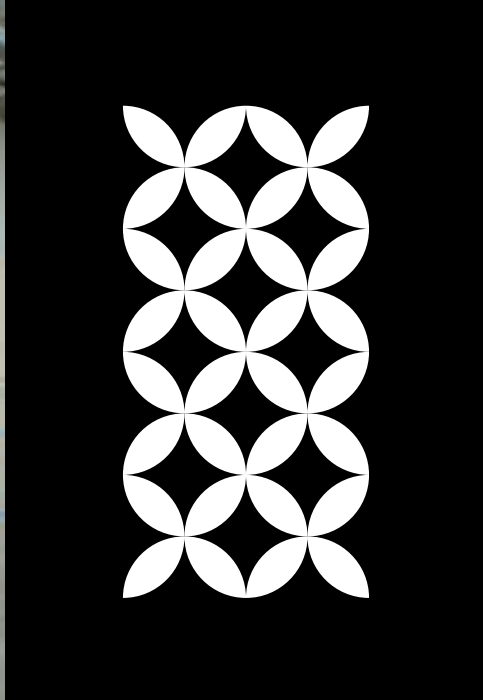
OUR MISSION & VALUES

- 4 new trainers gained





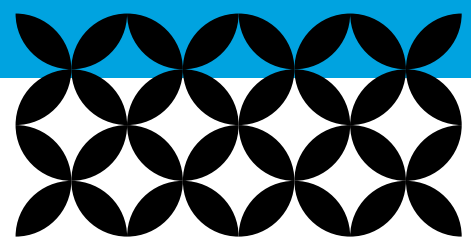
KEY PROGRAMS OVERVIEW

Athletics for All: Ensuring everyone is able to participate in roller derby, even those who have never skated or done another competitive sport before.

Financial Aid for Skaters: Our loaner library of equipment makes sure expensive skate gear is not a barrier to get started with our league. Plus, our membership dues hardship program allows skaters 3 months of due-free skating, with options for teammates to cover additional dues as donations.

Community Stewardship: Partnering with other nonprofits and the FoCo Junior Derby League and showing up to volunteer across Northern Colorado.

Fun for the Whole Family: Committed to fostering a game-day environment that is friendly for kids and parents alike.

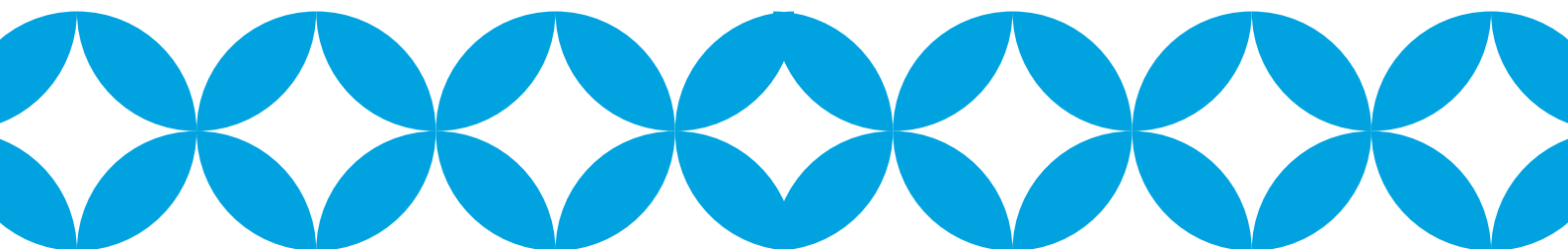

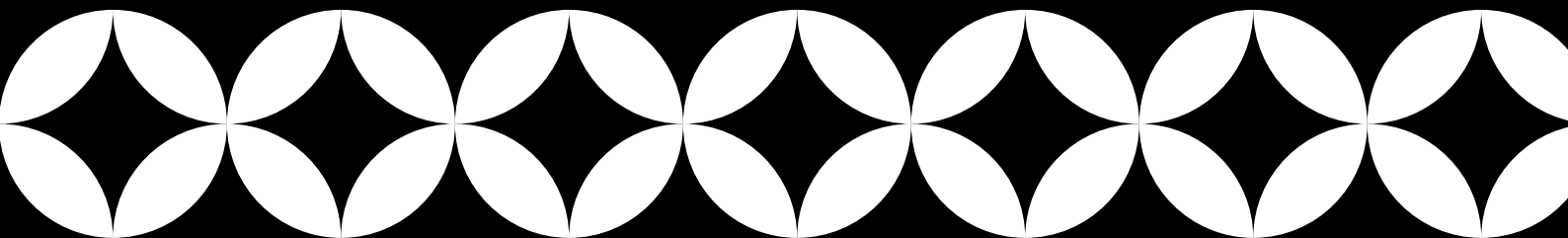

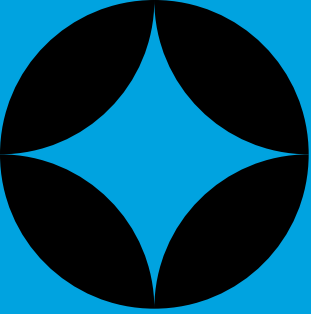




SKATING WITH PRIDE

- Did you know approximately **45% of our skaters and volunteers are LGBTQ+**?
- Results from our 2025 league skater survey revealed that skaters see our **welcoming and inclusive culture** as a major strength of the organization.
- **Our league is proud to accept transgender skaters** at a time when trans athletes are often banned from participating in sports in their community.





FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

Income Sources:

- 41% member dues
- 31% fundraisers
- 19% ticket sales
- 6% sponsorships
- 2% merchandise sales

Expenses:

- 92% facilities + athletics
- 3% events
- 2% marketing
- 2% yearly retreats
- 1% operations

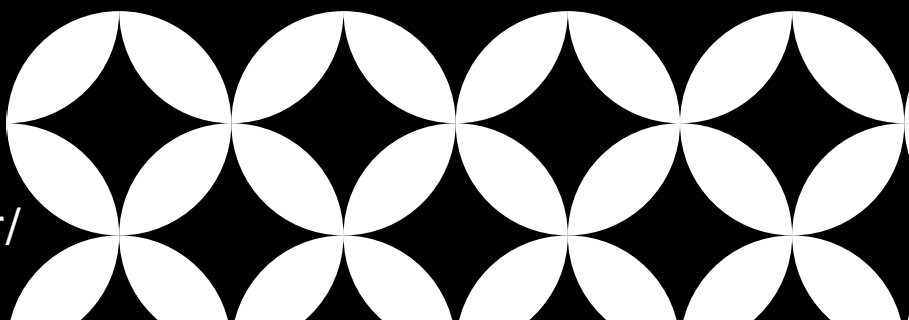

A note from our incoming President:

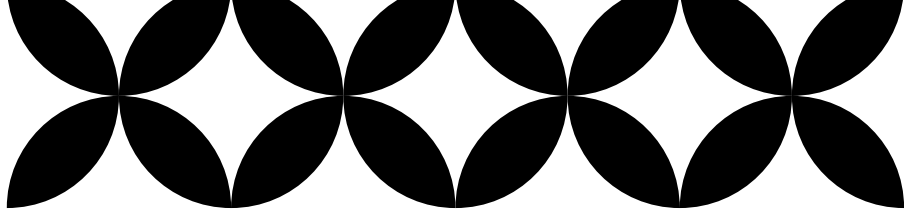

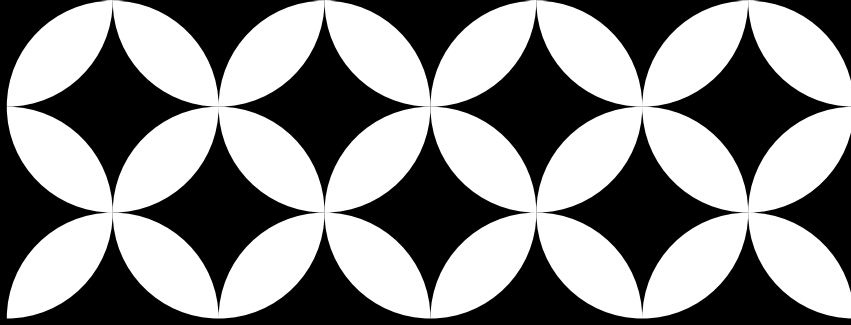




OUR 2026 GOALS

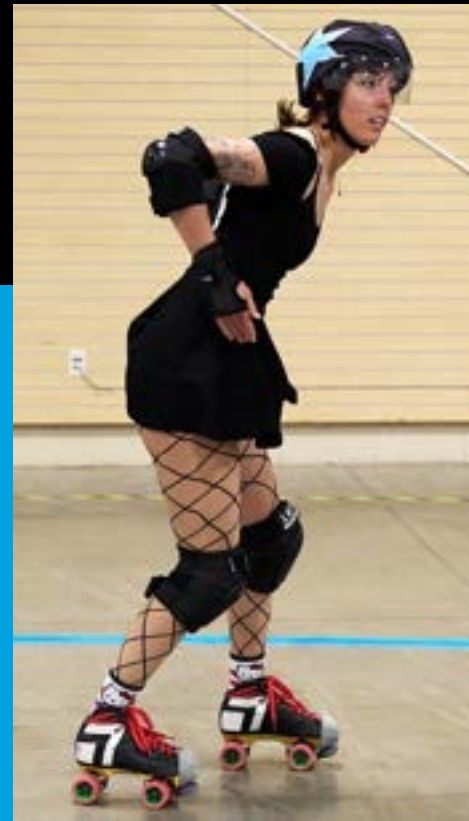
